- The external reviewer for the Psychology department did not suggest any major changes to the program. He stated that the department needs help with the PLOs revision. The committee compared the Psychology and Biology posted PLOs and will collaborate with the department on revising their PLOs.
- The Athletics Department was received; it contains a lot of useful data.

5. Records

6. Assessment and program review training (Department of History, TA, Political Science, E&B); RS request

- Four academic departments are working on their seven-year reports, namely, History, Political Science, TA and E&B.
